2 GUIDING PRINCIPLES

The following principles have informed the development of this Policy and shall guide its administration and implementation:

- ◇ **Fairness & Consistency** – that the Policy be fair and balanced in its requirements and consistent in its application and enforcement.
- ◇ **Transparency & Clarity** – that the delivery and administration of housing at BRFN be done in an open and transparent manner; that the Policy be clearly written and easily understood.
- ◇ **Collective Responsibility** – that the Policy be backed by the commitment and capacity of all parties involved to implement, administer, enforce, and abide by the Policy.
- ◇ **Best Practices** – that the Policy be in line with best practices; that the BRFN Housing Program be a model for other First Nations.
- ◇ **Accessibility** – that housing at BRFN be accessible to Members with a range of income levels.
- ◇ **Sustainability & Adaptability** – that the Housing Program be financially viable so that it can be sustained and expanded over the long-term; that the Policy be adaptable to continue to meet the evolving and expanding housing needs of BRFN.
